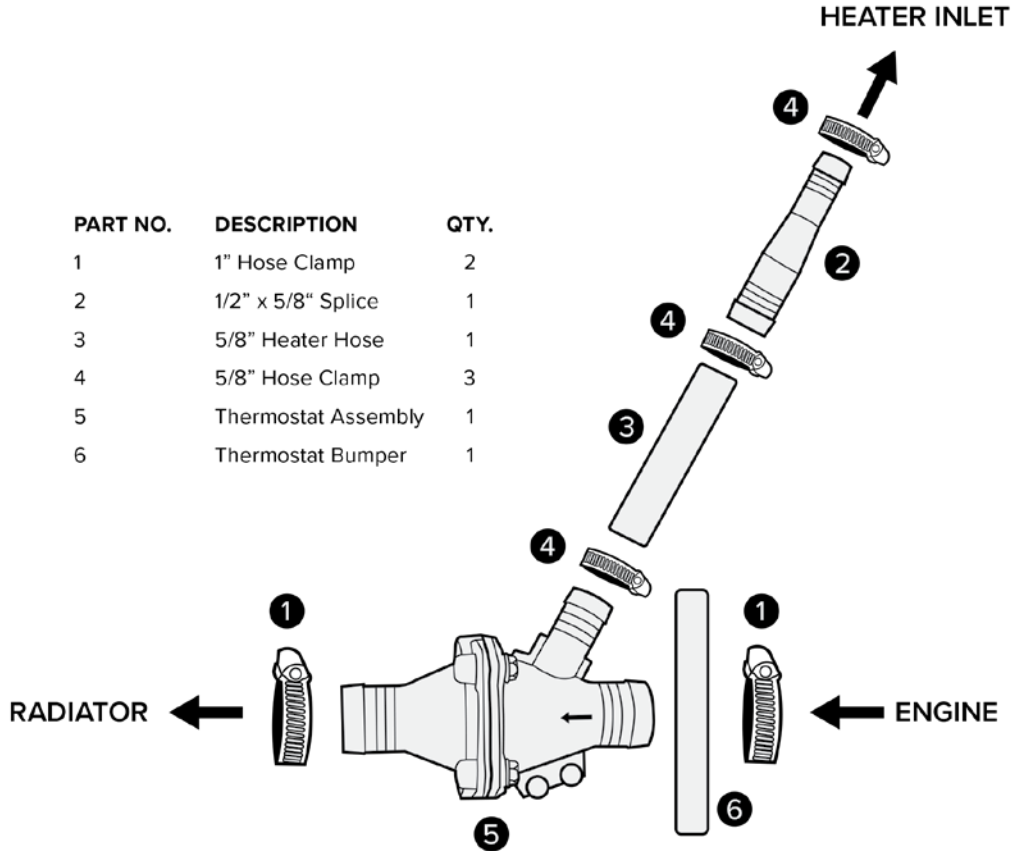


Do not discard packaging until product has been successfully installed.

CAUTION: Safety glasses and protective gloves should always be worn for installs. Severe damage can be caused if the air is not bled from the radiator system.

1	1" Hose Clamp	2
2	1/2" x 5/8" Splice	1
3	5/8" Heater Hose	1
4	5/8" Hose Clamp	3
5	Thermostat Assembly	1
6	Thermostat Bumper	1

- Before starting, allow the vehicle to cool.
NOTE: Hot coolant is under pressure and may cause serious injury
- Disconnect the battery power cable.
- Remove the radiator cap.
- If you already have a heater system installed you will replace the Y or Tee fitting you currently have on the radiator hose on the engine outlet side, leading to the heater system.
- Using three hose pliers, clamp the 2 radiator lines and 1 heater line connected to the Y or Tee fitting, to prevent the loss of engine coolant.
- Place a catch pan under the Y or Tee fitting to be removed, to catch any coolant that may be trapped between the pliers.
- Remove the Y or Tee fitting. Replace the Y or Tee fitting with the Thermostat (5). Orient the Thermostat (5) in radiator line as shown with arrow, where Thermostat forms a Y on the engine outlet side of the cut radiator hose. Secure Thermostat (5) with hose clamps (1) on the larger sides and hose clamp (4) on smaller port.
- If heater hose is 1/2", cut a piece of the 5/8" heater hose (3) to length. Clamp 5/8" heater hose (3) to heater outlet on Thermostat (5) and place 5/8" end of Splice (2) in opposite end of 5/8" hose. Clamp existing 1/2" heater hose to opposite end of Splice (2).

If adding a new heater system, follow the instructions on the installation of the heater and place the Thermostat (5) in the radiator heater hose on the engine outlet side, instead of one Y or Tee fitting. Orient the Thermostat (5) in radiator line as shown with arrow, where Thermostat forms a Y on the engine outlet side of the cut radiator hose. Secure Thermostat (5) with hose clamps (1) on the larger sides and hose clamp (4) on smaller port.
10. Remove hose pliers.
11. If needed, use the Thermostat bumper (6) for extra protection around the thermostat.
12. Connect the battery.
13. Fill cooling system and **BLEED AIR FROM THE SYSTEM** according to the service manual.
14. Run engine through two complete fan cycles. Allow to cool and top off engine coolant recovery bottle.
15. Periodically check coolant during the first couple hours of operations.
